The health and safety of workers is obviously the primary purpose for the majority of attendees to the co-located Safety In Action show and those attendees might be interested in CETEC's presentation on 'The Impact of Cleaning Products on Indoor Air Quality'. CETEC were specifically appointed to develop the NABERS system for Office Indoor Environment and this seminar looks at the impact of cleaning agents on the air quality within a building and in turn its effects on workers.
